

Dr. William Bryan is an environmental historian, author, and educator located in Atlanta, Georgia. He earned a Ph.D. from Penn State in 2013, and his research and writing explore land, water, and wildlife conservation in the United States. His first book, *The Price of Permanence: Nature and Business in the New South*, based on his award-winning Ph.D. dissertation, was published in 2018 by the University of Georgia Press. His writing has also been published in the *Washington Post*, *Saporta Report*, *Southern Cultures*, *Environmental History*, and *The New England Quarterly*. As an environmental educator, Dr. Bryan has designed and taught college courses at Emory University, Penn State, and Georgia State University, and has developed and led a variety of environmental education programs for the public.
